Program Objectives:

- Development of Leadership skills within Nebraska 4-H Shooting Sports participants, and the 4-H program in general
- Increased Public Speaking/Communication/Media skills
- Knowledge of how to approach teaching youth
- Build career skills for all participants
- Continue to grow and develop the Nebraska 4-H Shooting Sports Program

Eligibility:

- Participants must
 - Be at least fourteen (14) years 4-H Age
 - Enrolled for at least one (1) year in a Nebraska 4-H Shooting Sports Club/Program
 - Show interest in leadership roles in their club, school, or community, etc.
 - MUST be willing and able to attend the Ambassador Training November 19-21, 2016
 - Be willing to assist the Nebraska 4-H Shooting Sports Advisory Committee develop the State 4-H Shooting Sports Program for the remainder of their 4-H eligibility

Selection Process:

- 4-H Members will complete a formal application and submit it through the Google Form link provided by the program by 11:59 P.M. CST on November 4, 2016.
- 4-H Members MUST request 2 recommendations to be completed
 - 1 MUST be submitted by a Nebraska Extension Staff Member
 - 1 from another trustworthy (Non-Family Member) adult source (Age 21 or Over)
- The Nebraska 4-H Shooting Sports Coordinator will select a committee of five (5) willing members from the Nebraska 4-H Shooting Sports Advisory Committee to review all completed applications.
- After review of all applications, ten (10) - fifteen (15) youth will be selected to attend the 3 day seminar.
