

LIVESTOCK VET CHECK

- All livestock (cattle, goats, rabbits, swine and sheep) must have their health papers checked in Brunk's lot south of Stolley Park Road by a State Vet
- Please review the schedule of the Vet Check hours on the 4-H Livestock Schedule
- 4-H Exhibitors will pick up their exhibitor packet which will include their weigh cards, backtags, chute and stand permits, etc.




LIVESTOCK PARKING PROCEDURES


- All animal exhibitors (with the exception of Poultry) will be required to come through Brunk's Lot to have their health papers and animals reviewed by a vet.
- After unloading tack and livestock, exhibitors can park their trailers in Brunk's Lot at no charge. A permit is not required for trailers.
- Trailers should not be parked in general parking (lots west of the livestock barns).
- Designated volunteers will be available to help navigate exhibitors to gates/location of the barn, etc.




LIVESTOCK EXHIBITOR PARKING (3A/3B)







4-H LIVESTOCK RELEASE

- Breeding Beef, Breeding Swine and Poultry can begin release on Saturday, August 26 between the hours of 6 PM-9 PM. Beef exhibitors will be able to drive through the barn if breeding beef show is concluded.
- All animals will need to stay in place until Sunday, August 27 until 1 PM. At 1 PM, all animals begin load out. Exhibitors will not be able to drive through the barns until the conclusion of the show(s). Until the conclusion of the shows, beef exhibitors will access the south side of the beef barn and exit gate #2 and sheep/goat exhibitors will load on the north side of the barn and exit gate #2.
