- Carbon monoxide- poison
- Formaldehyde- used to embalm dead bodies
- Hydrazine- used in jet and rocket fuels
- Polonium- radiation dosage, equal to 300 chest X-rays a year.
- Stearic Acid- found in candle wax
- Styrene- found in Styrofoam
- Toluene- embalmer's glue
