Featuring Guest Speakers:

Randy Hampton retired from a 34 year career at the Lincoln Journal Star as a photojournalist and photo editor. Randy was also an adjunct professor at the University of Nebraska College of Journalism for 20 years. Currently Randy is a photography consultant at Rockbrook Camera and teaches Digital Photography Workshops. Randy speaks in easy to understand terms and will give practical advice to both beginners and advanced students.

Brad Norton Brad Norton is a staff photographer for the Kearney Hub daily newspaper. Brad shoots a wide variety of subjects including area sports, news and any number of editorial topics. Brad has been on the staff of the Hub for 19 years and has been know to climb tall trees just to get the photo! Serious! Awards won include the Associated Press, Nebraska Press Photographers Assn., National Press Photographers Assn., and the Calgary Stampede.

Jeff Beiermann has been a staff photographer at the Omaha World-Herald for 14 years. Prior to that he was a contract photographer for the Associated Press and worked at the Fremont Tribune. He is a Nebraska native and grew up in Clarkson, Nebraska after coming back to the state at age 5. Whether it's covering Huskers, presidential politics, or the local chef-of-the-week, he does them all. And not always working under the ideal conditions (or ideal people). But, a picture always has to be made and usually under a deadline, so he'll share the some tips and tricks on how to get that photo.

Tim O'Neill has been involved in the photography business since 1976 where as a kid he was introduced to photography though the High School yearbook. Formal training at the US Naval School of Photography and a 5 year stint as a combat photographer rounded out his training in photojournalism. Since the military Tim has had years of shooting and as a darkroom tech. Tim currently has a photogrpahy business in North Platte and taught Photoshop to groups like you!

Some of the classes include:

Digital Day Long -Fine tune your digital skills with your camera during this hands-on day-long workshop. Topics covered include: camera functions, advanced exposure control, white balance control, photographic techniques, lighting, editing, and workflow. This workshop will include outdoor shooting assignments. **Randy Hampton** will answer your questions and give you an opportunity to explore this now well-established medium in the photographic world. Students taking this course will spend all day Saturday with Randy. This is for the photographer who is beyond beginning level and is limited to 20 participants.

Digital- We will explore the variety of equipment and cut through the avalanche of information about buying and using a digital camera. We will set up a digital darkroom for your use during the workshop. We will be using Adobe Photoshop Elements with this class.

Beginners Class- Did you just get a new camera? **Brad Mellema** will instruct beginning level classes for people who want to figure out how great photographs are made. We will look at composition and exposure, and have plenty of practice in the field.

Field Trips - We will take field trips to the surrounding sandhill areas to take pictures with the pros. Visit a working cattle ranch and the Nebraska Nationa Forest for incredible photo opportunities.

Sports Photography- Ever try to make great sports images only to have blurry or under exposed images? Sports photography can be a lot of fun if you know how to approach picture taking under the lights or in the gym. **Jeff Beiermann** will put his years of experience into a workshop showing you ways to succeed.

Available Light Portaiture - Brad Norton, Staff Photographer with the Kearney Hub will show you how he approaches something we all do, people portraits with very little equipment. Posing, Lighting, and equipment will be gone over to help you be a better portrait photgrpaher.

Intro to Digital Painting - Instructor **Tim O'Neil** will guide you through the interesting and creative world of digital painting. This is the process of taking your image and transforming it into a painting. This is a great way to make your photography stand out.
