Attend two Non-County Shoots

Demonstrate Leadership at the County Shoot

Personal Interview with an Adult

- Oral report back to an instructor

Enroll as a Junior Leader or a similar 4-H Leadership project

Written Report (3 pages), double spacing is OK

Oral Presentation (10 to 12 minutes)

Suggested Topics written/oral reports (others can be used but must be different subject for each and not used in Level II)

- types of shotguns

- proper care and storage of shotgun

- proper fit of equipment

- explain differences in types of shotgun events (skeet, sporting clays, trap)

- wildlife hunted with shotgun and load used

- history

- laws
