Who can come? Attendance at UYC is limited to 16 returning participants who will be in grades 9 to 12 next fall. ***Note: Application deadline is April 1.***

When? UYC will begin Sunday, June 8 and end Wednesday, June 11.

Where? UYC will be held at the Nebraska State Capitol as well as the University of Nebraska-Lincoln, Burr Hall. Burr Hall is located on East Campus, just east of 33rd and Holdrege streets in Lincoln.

The cost? \$200. (**Note the registration deadline listed above**). The cost includes all meals and programs in the conference. Please make your check payable to UNL-SREC.

** A limited number of scholarships are available. To apply for a scholarship, please answer the following questions on a separate sheet of paper and return it with your registration form: Why do I need the scholarship? Why do I want to come to UYC? **

What should I bring?
