Please carefully read the enclosed information about 4-H Horse Stampede.

The 2023 Horse Stampede contest is scheduled for Saturday, March 25th in the University of Nebraska-Lincoln Animal Science Complex.

Depending on the direction you are coming from; I recommend the following:

- From the west - go to 33rd and Holdrege Street, head east on Holdrege Street and turn north onto East Campus Loup. Head east on East Campus Loup and turn north on North 39th street. Follow the street until the road ends, in front of you will be the Animal Science Building, parking will be on your right in the C commuter lot.
- From the East- go to North 48th and Holdrege Street, head west on Holdrege Street and turn north onto East Campus Loup. Similar to previous directions, head north on N 39th street to get to the Animal Science Complex.

Parking is free on campus. It is recommended that you park in the parking lot at 39th and Fair St. as the doors on the south side of the Animal Science Complex will be open. Please do not leave vehicles in the unloading spots on Fair St. outside of the building.

GENERAL CONTEST PROCEDURES:

The show procedures are described in "[Nebraska 4-H Horse Show and Judging Guide](#)" and the website. Exhibitors are expected to read and follow the information in the letter to know all details regarding the 4-H Horse Stampede contest. Printed rulebooks will be available for purchase at \$10/each and arms at \$5/each. You will see that attached is the Public Speaking and Demonstration working order.

Food: We currently do not plan to have a food vendor on campus, but there are many food locations within a short driving distance of the facility. Outside food and drinks will be allowed into the building. Please clean up after yourself if you bring in outside food. Otherwise, if you bought a lunch it will be provided through lunch tickets.

INFORMATION RELATED TO CONTESTS:

- All art and photography exhibits must be dropped off at check in the day of the event.
 - Make sure all photography exhibits have photography data tags.
- Coaches should be the only people that check-in teams for Horse Bowl
