Hello exhibitors! Below you will find important information for the upcoming expo. Please carefully read the enclosed information and refer to the additional information available from the web link: https://4h.unl.edu/state-horse-expo-contests

The 2023 Fonner Park State 4-H Horse Expo is scheduled for Saturday, July 15th to Wednesday, July 19th at the Fonner Park grounds in Grand Island, Nebraska.

GENERAL SHOW PROCEDURES:

The show procedures, attire, and rules are described in "2023 Nebraska 4-H Horse Show and Judging Guide".

Upon Arrival for the – Hippology Contest:

Check-in will start at 5:30 pm Saturday, July 15th at the Fonner Park Bosselman Center (directions can be found on the map listed below). It is preferred that coaches come and check in with teams during this time, but parents can also if coaches are not planning to attend.

It is recommended that youth bring their own writing utensils.

Upon Arrival for the Horse Judging (& second portion of the hippology contest):

Check-in will be on Sunday, July 16th from 12:00 pm to 1:30 pm at the Bosselman Building (directions can be found on the map listed below). It is preferred that coaches come and check in with teams during this time, but parents can also if coaches are not planning to attend. Hippology teams will also have to check in "again" for the Horse Judging portion of the contest.

It is recommended that youth bring their own writing utensils and paper.

Results of both Hippology and Horse Judging contests will be announced in the Indoor Thompson Arena on Monday, July 17th after all Western Pleasure classes have finished. We strongly recommend that teams attend the awards ceremony to have a professional photo taken for future use. Please note that awards will only be distributed during this event and will not be sent by mail at a later time. If members of a team will not be in attendance, please find a designated representative to pick up all your team's awards.








Eligibility

- See General Contest Rules to determine the number of teams each county may enter at the State Contest.
- Contestants must be enrolled in the 4-H horse project.
- Nebraska 4-H Horse Show dress code required. Exception no hats or headgear permitted.
- At the Fonner Park State 4-H Expo, an individual may compete in either Judging or Hippology, not both.
- Contestants must not have participated in any post-secondary (university, college, junior college, or technical school) competitive horse judging or hippology contests. Neither can a contestant be a member of a post-secondary team undergoing training in preparation for such an event.
- Youth who previously represented Nebraska at a national contest in the hippology or horse judging contest area is not eligible for further participation in that event at the state level.
- The winning team will have the first choice of the contest they wish to compete in; the reserve team will also be allowed to represent Nebraska at a different contest. Financial support for these teams will be supplied through the State 4-H Office.

Other types of lodging

4-H families are highly encouraged to book hotel rooms and reserve camper/RV hookups as early as possible. Camper/RV hookups will be available on a first-come-first-serve basis, and reservations can be made by contacting Kathy at 308-382-4515. Camper parking will be on the north side of the grounds along Fonner Park Road in the RV Park. Fonner Park requests that NO camper/living quarter trailers be on the ground prior to noon, Friday before the start of the show on Saturday. Parking will be available in the afternoon on Friday. However, trailers/campers cannot be left unattended to prevent theft and vandalism to your property as this has been an issue in the past. A \$35 fee per day will be charged for all trailers/campers throughout the event. Camping on the show grounds next to the barns is only permitted if you have your own generator. Anyone that is plugged into the barns for electricity will be cited and unplugged for each day of use.

Good sportsmanship is expected of exhibitors, their families, and friends at all times. Being pleasant and respectful of others is as important in the show arena and on the show grounds.




