Certification Program

Individuals must attend both days of the workshop to earn their certification in the discipline.

A new certification being offered in Nebraska 4-H Shooting Sports – Coordinator. This is for county staff who work with certified shooting sports leaders, 4-H club leaders for shooting sports projects, or 4-H volunteers managing shooting sports events/competitions. Coordinators will learn about the different disciplines, fund-raising, Positive Youth Development, handling conflict, and more during the workshop.
