

#### LIVESTOCK VET CHECK AND PACKETS

- All livestock (cattle, goats, swine and sheep)
  must have their livestock inspected by a State
  Vet in checked in the livestock trailer lot
- Please review the arrival hours on the livestock arrival and departure schedule
- 4-H Exhibitors will pick up their exhibitor packet in the livestock trailer. Packets will include all purchases items such as gate tickets, wristbands, parking permits and chute/stand permits. Packets will also include weigh cards, back tags, and stall cards.



#### ROUTINE INSPECTION PROCEDURES

- Representatives of the show will meet the incoming vehicle at the designated area in the staging area (Livestock Trailer Lot). This could be the official Nebraska State Fair Veterinarian or other veterinarians on staff during the show.
- A visual inspection of the animal is to be made.
- If all animals with that vehicle meet all entry requirements, then vehicle will be allowed to proceed onto Fonner Park.
- If all animals with that vehicle do not meet the requirements, the vehicle should move where directed to allow continual traffic flow. If an animal must be unloaded, they will be placed in the quarantine area away from other animals.
- The Nebraska State Fair Veterinarian will have the final call on questions about health of an animal, and whether they are allowed to enter Fonner Park.





#### LIVESTOCK PARKING PROCEDURES

- After unloading tack and livestock, exhibitors can park their trailers in the Livestock Trailer Lot (formerly Brunk's Lot) at no charge. A permit is not required for trailers.
- Trailers should not be parked in general parking (lots west of the livestock barns).
- Designated volunteers will be available to help navigate exhibitors to gates/location of the barn, etc.
- Exhibitors may purchase an "Exhibitor Parking Permit" which can be used in 3A (west of swine barn) or 3B (Livestock Trailer Lot).




# LIVESTOCK EXHIBITOR PARKING (3A/3B)







