

HUNT SEAT EQUITATION

Senior Pattern

Be ready at A.

1. Canter on the right lead to and around B.
2. Halfway between B and C, perform a simple or flying lead change.
3. Canter on left lead to and around C.
4. Posting trot on the left diagonal from C to D.
5. At D, change diagonals and continue to trot to B.
6. At B, sitting trot to C.
7. Stop and back one horse length at C.



HUNT SEAT EQUITATION



Junior Pattern

Be ready at A.

1. Walk to B.
2. Stop at B and perform a 90 degree turn to the right on the forehand.
3. Canter on the left lead to C.
4. Posting trot from C to D.
5. Canter on the right lead from D to C.
6. Posting trot from C to B.
7. Stop at B and back one horse length.



WESTERN HORSEMANSHIP

Junior Pattern

Be ready at A

1. Walk A to B.
2. Jog a half circle to C.
3. Lope a half circle on the left lead to D.
4. Extend the jog in a half circle to C.
5. Lope a half circle on the right lead to B.
6. Walk to E.
7. Stope at E and back approximately one horse length.



WESTERN HORSEMANSHIP



Elementary Pattern

Begin before A at a jog.

1. Jog from A to B.
2. At B, lope on the left lead and circle at B as shown. Stop facing B.
3. Turn $\frac{1}{4}$ turn to the left
4. Back one horse length.
5. Jog to C. Stop at C.



REINING

Senior Pattern

Nebraska 4-H Reining Pattern
#6



1. Begin at center of the arena facing left wall or fence. Begin on left lead and complete 2 circles to the left, the first one large and fast, the second one small and slow.
 2. At center of arena, stop and complete 3 spins to the left. Hesitate.
 3. Begin on the right lead. Complete 2 circles to the right, the first one large and fast, the second on small and slow.
 4. At center of the arena, stop and complete 3 spins to the right. Hesitate.
 5. Begin on left lead and make a figure eight on top of the large circles, flying change of leads at center of arena.
 6. Close figure eight and begin large fast circle to the left. Do not close this circle, but run straight down the side past the center of the arena and do a right rollback at least 20 feet from the wall or fence, no hesitation.
 7. Continue back around previous circle. Do not close this circle but run straight down the opposite side of arena past the center marker, and do a left rollback at least 20 feet from the wall or fence, no hesitation.
 8. Continue back around previous circle. Do not close this circle but run straight down the side past the center marker and do a sliding stop at least 20 feet from the wall or fence. Back over the slide tracks a minimum of 10 feet.
- Hesitate to demonstrate completion of the pattern.
The bridle may be dropped at the judge's discretion.





REINING

Junior Pattern

Nebraska 4-H Reining Pattern
#3



Begin the pattern facing the judge.

1. Trot to the center of the arena facing the judge; stop before beginning the pattern.
2. Complete two spins to the right, hesitate.
3. Complete two spins to the left, hesitate.
4. Run two circles to the right, the first a small slow circle, the second a large fast circle. Change leads at the center of the arena.
5. Run two circles to the left, the first a small slow circle, the second a large fast circle. Change leads at the center of the arena.
6. Begin a circle to the right, do not close the circle but instead run to the end of the arena. Remain at least 20 feet from the fence.
7. Run past the center marker, stop, and do a rollback toward the fence.
8. Run back around the end of the arena and down the fence, remaining at least 20 feet from the fence.
9. Run past the center marker, stop, and do a rollback toward the fence.
10. Run around the end of the arena and down the fence past the center marker. Stop and back at least 15 feet.
11. Hesitate to show completion of the pattern.
12. The bridle may be dropped at the judge's discretion.
