## Evaluate Your Floor Plan

Use this checklist to evaluate your floor plan

- Furniture is grouped according to use. (For example, the desk and chair near the bookshelves for studying, or a dresser near the closet.)
- Placement of furniture allows for easy movement around the room. Heating, ventilation, and light sources are not blocked.
- Large pieces of furniture placed in the room first; smaller items arranged around them.
- Doors, windows, and drawers have room to open, and there is legroom around chairs and beds.
- An interesting focal point is created with a large piece of furniture, window treatment, or a display of a personal collection.
- There is space for the room's main activities.
