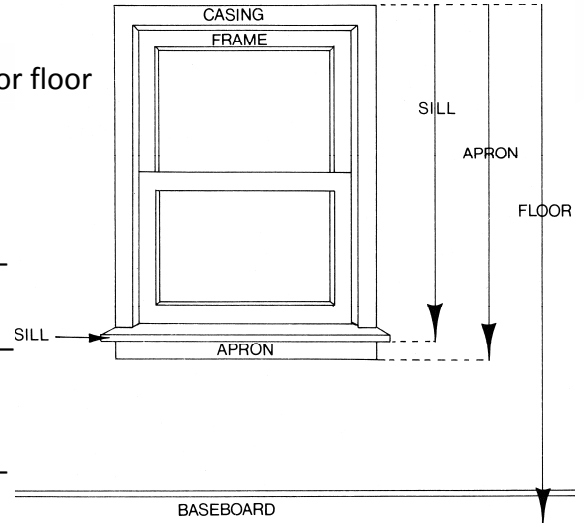




DESIGN DECISIONS
